

# **RIVER CITY CYCLING CLUB (RCCC) SCHOLARSHIP**

## **Essay and Application Requirements**

The River City Cycling Club is a local bicycling club; our mission is to give-back to the community with contributions to local charities and college scholarship awards; funding is from the annual Tarwheel Century. This Northeast North Carolina cycling event draws hundreds of bicyclists who enjoy touring the area. This year the club will award two (2) \$1000 scholarships to winners of the RCCC Essay Contest, plus meeting the requirements below.

### **DEADLINE TO APPLY - APRIL 30, 2012**

#### **To be eligible, applicants must comply with the following requirements:**

- (a) Must be a 2012 high school graduate from Pasquotank, Perquimans or Camden county schools;
- (b) Must be accepted to a 4 year college or university and plan to attend in fall 2012;
- (c) Must have a minimum of 2.5 GPA;
- (d) Must write and submit a 500 word essay entitled: "Life Lessons Learned From Playing My Favorite Sport or School Activity";
- (e) Must state why he or she needs the scholarship.

#### **Essay format:**

- Centered on the first page should include:

**Your full name**  
**Street Address**  
**City, State Zip Code**  
**Phone Number (including area code)**  
**E-mail address**  
**Name of the college or university you plan to attend**

- Drop two spaces and center the essay title:

**Life Lessons Learned From Playing My Favorite Sport or School Activity**

- Drop two spaces, and in the left margin begin: **Why I Need The Scholarship**

**Deadline for submission:** The contestant must submit his or her essay in Microsoft Word format to the Guidance Counselor for review and submission on or before, April 30, 2012.
